The business meeting will start at 7 PM - brief business session followed by the educational presentation. Our meetings provide:

Join our VHF net every non-meeting Monday evening. See the WOTLM Net page for details. The NØXLF repeater frequency is: 147.075 MHz, +600 offset (i.e., 147.675). A 131.8 Hz CTCSS tone is required to access the repeater. We recommend leaving the "Tone Squelch" off. Please add this frequency to your frequency list.



- Seek and you shall find You have expectations ... we have expectations
- It's your choice to get out of your comfort zone
- You only get answers to the questions you ask, we cannot be all things to all people
- Surround yourself with good people
- Send an email ... wait for an answer
- When you personally contact an Elmer, clear the time
- Have a list of questions or a specific topic
- Have a notepad
 Write down the advice you get

SOME TIPS

- Maybe just a little bit ahead of us or way in the distance
- Who do we follow or ask for advice, not all are a perfect fit
- Mentor will help you see farther and stretch your abilities

- Lifelong learning, it is a hobby of 1,000 hobbies


